State Touch Football

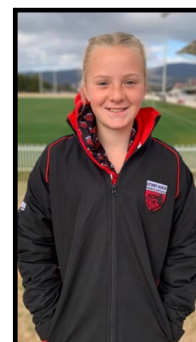
Emmerson is currently away competing in the Sydney North Touch competition. The team is doing extremely well and is playing the final rounds today. We wish Emmerson the best of luck!

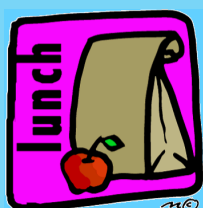

Scholastic Book Fair

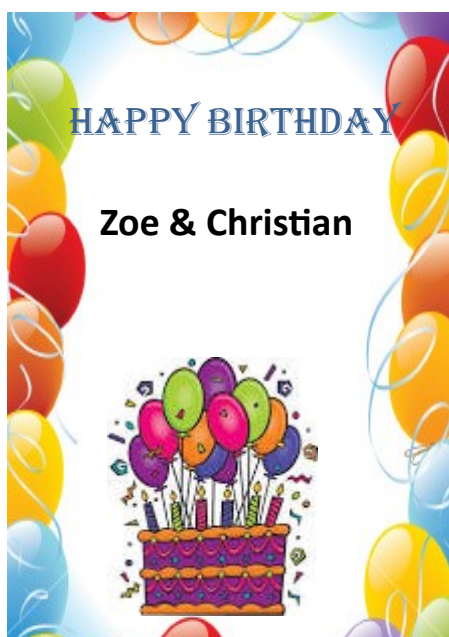
Thank you to everyone who supported our annual Book Fair last week. Total sales were over \$900 and we received almost \$200 worth of books for our school as commission.

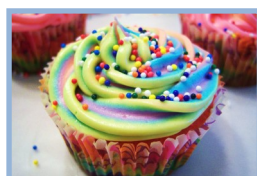

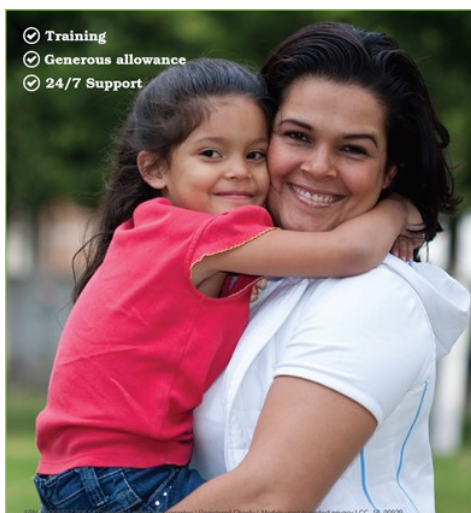
