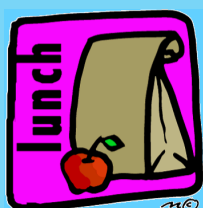

**Session 1:** 6pm-7pm **Where did I come from?** Targeted at Years 3,4,5,6 and their parents/carers.

**Session 2:** 7pm-8pm **Preparing for puberty.** Targeted at Years 5 & 6 and their parents. (Years 3 & 4 at parental discretion)

**Cost:** \$32 per family to attend 1 session OR \$37 per family to attend both sessions.

The content has been developed to provide sequential learning while building and enhancing the children's relationship skills. These programs will be delivered by educators from interrelate in a supportive environment.

### Session 1: Where Did I Come From?

**Audience:** Year 3 and 4 students and their parents/carers

**Program focus:** Discuss the male and female reproductive systems, foetal development and the birth process, personal safety and protective behaviours

**Note:** Older students are encouraged to attend if they haven't previously seen this program

### Session 2: Preparing For Puberty

**Audience:** Year 5 and 6 students and their parents/carers.

**Program focus:** Discuss the physical changes of puberty, emphasising that it can be different for everyone. Develop students' understanding of periods and sperm production, as well as the physical, emotional, social and intellectual changes associated with puberty for both boys and girls. Enhance awareness of children's personal safety and protective behaviours.

**Note:** Younger students are welcome to attend at the discretion of their parents/carers
